

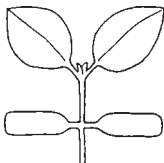

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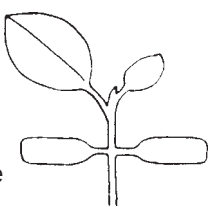

TERMINOLOGY

Opposite Leaves


Attached at same node on opposite sides of stem. Leaves at the same node are of similar size.

Alternate Leaves


One leaf per node. Leaves increase in size from top to bottom.

Cotyledon Shapes


(1) Linear



(2) Ovate



(3) Round



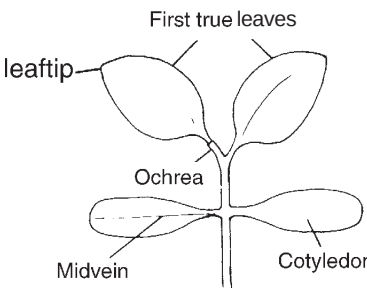
(4) Spatulate



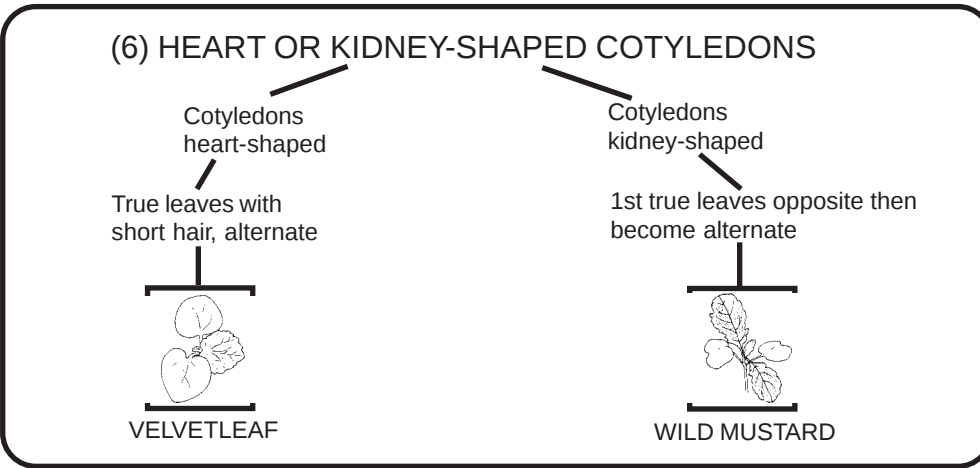
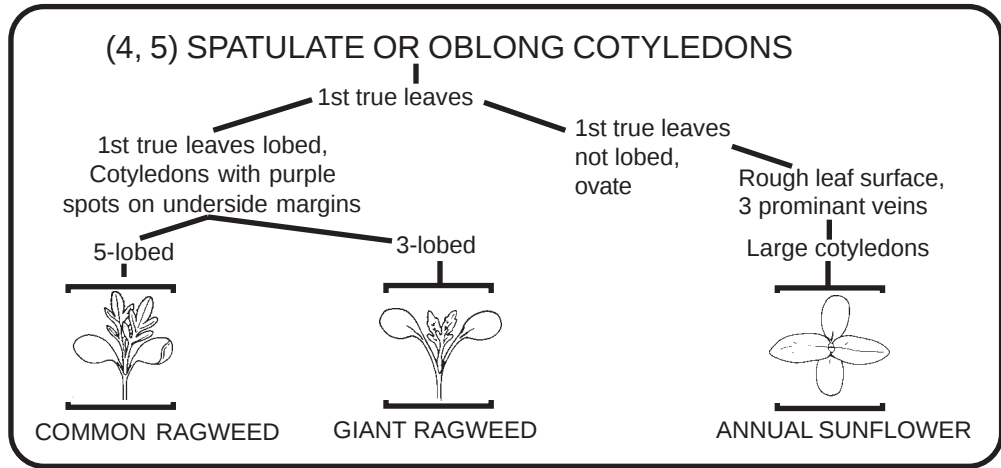
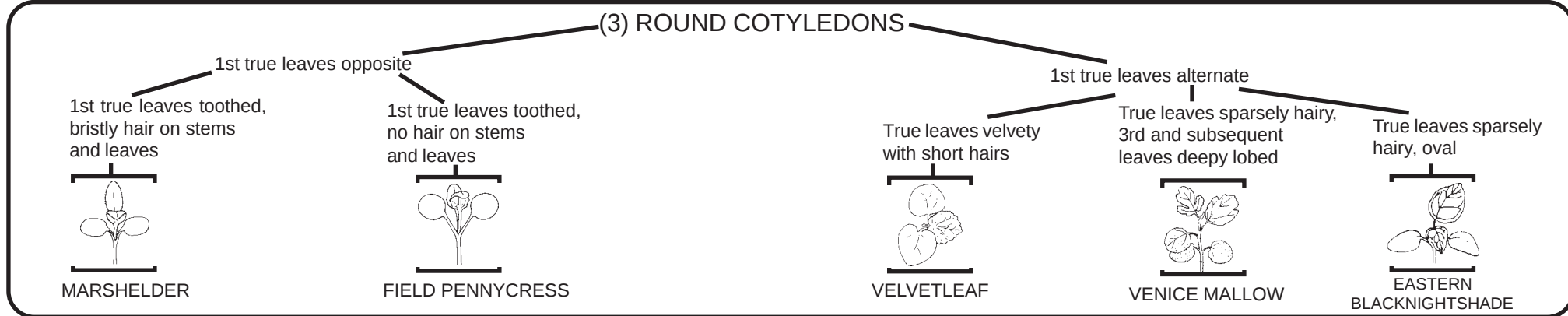
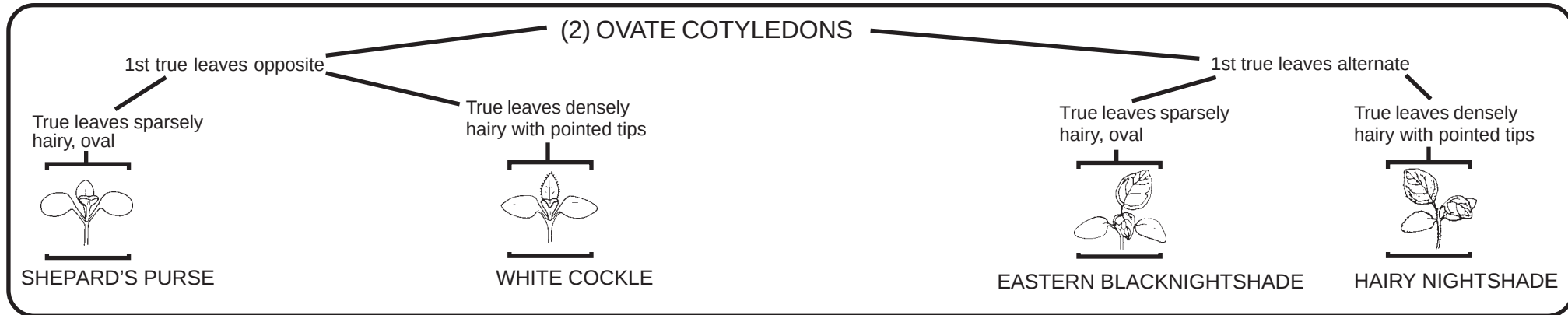
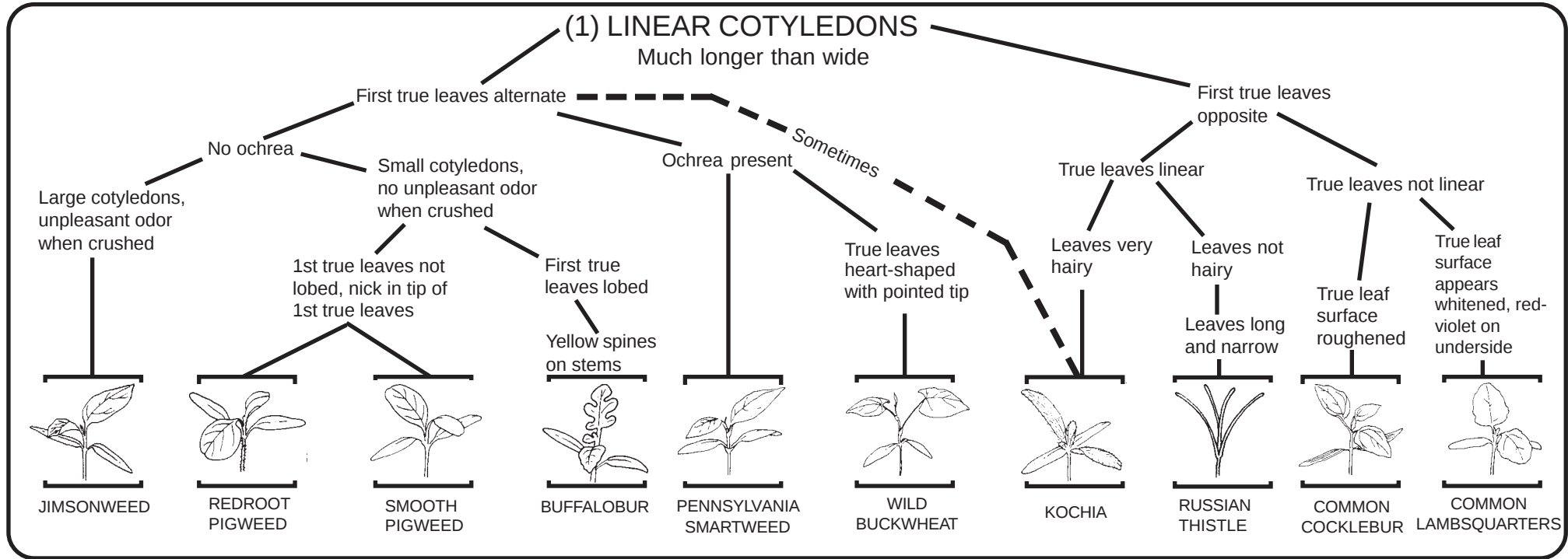
(5) Oblong
